

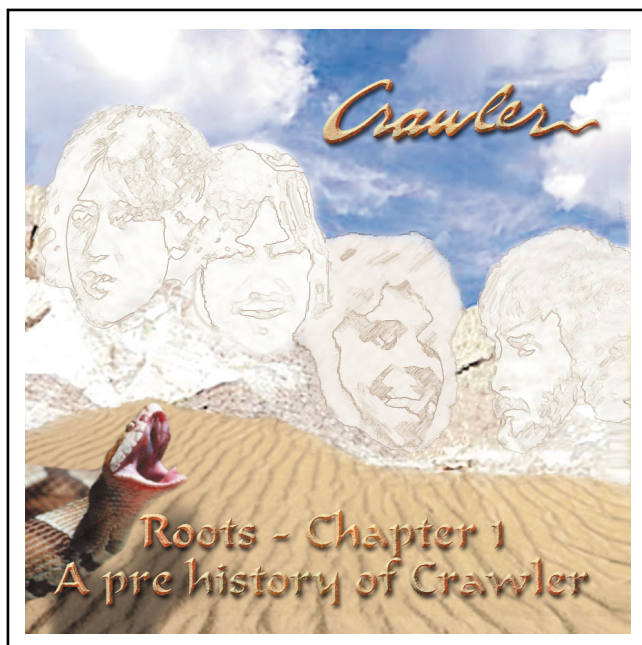

The story of **Paul Kossoff** often tells us that he put together **Back Street Crawler**, and after his death that band evolved into the tighter, funkier **Crawler** unit once guitarist **Geoff Whitehorn** was added. While this is in many ways true, the factual history of the band is actually much more involved, and goes back much further. This CD represents a PRE-history of that band, the bulk of the Crawler unit heard here in one of its earlier and less fixed incantations, prior to the formation of the **Paul Kossoff band**. The recordings here come from an unfinished project, leading up almost to the forming of **Back Street Crawler**, and are all tied in with the rhythm section of that band; **Bundrick, Wilson and Braunagel**.

Songs like the excellent 'Get The Feeling' have been lying unreleased for far too long, and tracks like 'I'll Be Dog Gone' and 'We All Need Love' show the Little Feat influence. The quality of the material here speaks for itself, and had a little more energy been invested to complete it at the time; this would have been a very good album.

Topping and tailing this set is the excellent 'Better Be Ready'. The initial demo that opens this set never included a vocal, but **Rabbit** did rediscover the track during some sessions he did in 1984, and that finished version closes the CD in a more complete but re-recorded form.

Most bands' pre-histories often only include a few aborted attempts at demos but here it's interesting to be afforded the opportunity to hear a much more involved and evolved growth. Over a decade before **Crawler** were named the three main musicians here (**Bundrick, Braunagel & Wilson**) have produced a fine selection of recorded music, and even now they remain in touch, and friends. The odd recording session still takes place when time permits, and who knows, maybe a Crawler 'post' history is in order!
